- 5. Discussion Item: 2017 year in review. Presented by Phil Mueller.
- 6. Committee introduction and reports:

 AS/KB. Reported on activity for 2017. Member Hirst will be leaving the ACC. Member Sellers volunteered to join the ACC. A LOT of discussion was had about our CCRs and that neither the ACC or the BOD has the right to allow any variance to what is written. 7. Front Entrance Discussion.

Issue was brought to the attention of the Board by Calvin Gee a few months ago that our entrance is not befitting the value of our community. The board weighed the issue and decided to bring it to the annual meeting for member discussion as it will be a large dollar value item. CR contacted both residents that adjoin the entrance and has been given permission to extend the fencing should it be deemed appropriate. Some members suggested the following modifications or improvements:

- Upgrade and enhance the project up to a dollar value that could be handled out of our savings and not bring a special assessment to all members, which would require a vote.
- Bid post and stringer removal and replacement.
- Bid stone work cleaning and additions.
- Bid replanting.
- It was also discussed that the flags should be moved to a more visible area.
- It was suggested the electrical post wire should be moved and that the lighting needs an upgrade.

9. Election and Quorum Update

- a. Total quorum count (50% of lot owner + 1 = 162). Quorum not achieved by electronic, mail in or in person counts. CR will contact members to close out the meeting at the monthly March meeting.
